(Cap. 271)

THE CUSTOMS (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1982

Short title.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by Section 248 of the Customs Act, the President acting in accordance with the advice of the Cabinet, hereby makes the following Regulations:

1. Regulation 167 of the Customs Regulations is hereby revoked and replaced by the following new regulation.

“Unlicensed 167. No unlicensed boat shall go or remain along-side or approach within two hundred metres of any aircraft or ship except with the written permission of the Comptroller and subject to such conditions and limitations as may be expressed therein.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport).

The object of this Regulation is to increase from 50 yards to 200 metres, the distance within which canoes and other craft are allowed to approach any vessel, so as to tighten security at the Port.
