The 1966/67 Appropriation Act, 1966

Short title.

**Being An Act to Provide for the Service of Sierra Leone for
the year 1966/67**

[1st July, 1966.]

Date of
Commence-
ment.

WHEREAS it is necessary to make provision for the service of
Sierra Leone for the year 1966/67:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent
Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the House of Repre-
sentatives in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority
of the same as follows:—

1. This Act shall come into operation on the 1st day of July,
1966.

Commence-
ment.

Le34,113,508 granted for 1966/67. 2. The sum of thirty-four million, one hundred and thirteen thousand, five hundred and eight Leones shall be and is hereby granted to Her Majesty the Queen, Her Heirs and Successors for and during the year nineteen hundred and sixty-six/sixty-seven and the same shall be applied and expended in the manner herein described and for the several services set forth in the First and Second Schedules.

Le34,113,508 charged on the revenue for 1966/67. 3. The said sum of thirty-four million, one hundred and thirteen thousand, five hundred and eight Leones shall be and is hereby declared to be charged upon and made payable from and out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the year nineteen hundred and sixty-six/sixty-seven and the payment thereof shall be taken to begin and commence on and immediately after the first day of July, nineteen hundred and sixty-six.

Accountant-General's authority for payment. 4. The Accountant-General is hereby authorised and required from time to time, upon the Warrant or Order of the Minister of Finance, to pay out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the several services specified in the First and Second Schedules the sum of thirty-four million, one hundred and thirteen thousand, five hundred and eight Leones which will come in course of payment during the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, nineteen hundred and sixty-seven.

Excess of Expenditure. 5. The amount from time to time paid for and in respect of the expenditure authorised in section 2 shall not exceed in the gross the sum of thirty-four million, one hundred and thirteen thousand, five hundred and eight Leones from the first day of July, nineteen hundred and sixty-six inclusive, and any balances remaining unissued at the end of June, nineteen hundred and sixty-seven, shall lapse and not be available for making payments in the following year.
