The Legal Practitioners (Amendment) Act, 1981

Short title.

Being an Act to amend the Legal Practitioners Act so as to allow Barristers or Solicitors serving their pupillage in the Judicial or Legal Service of the Government of Sierra Leone to practise or have a right of audience in the High Court during their period of pupillage; and for matters consequential or incidental thereto.

[10th December, 1981]

Date of Commencement.

BE IT ENACTED by the President and Members of Parliament in this present Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1. Paragraph (b) of sub-section (6) of Section 7A of the Legal Practitioners Act is hereby amended as follows:—

Amendment of Section 3 of Cap. 11.

- (i) by deleting the semicolon at the end of sub-paragraph (b) thereof and by substituting therefor a colon; and
- (ii) by adding immediately after sub-paragraph (b) the following proviso—

“Provided that a person to whom a Certificate of Temporary Registration has been granted and who is in the Judicial or Legal Service of the Government of Sierra Leone shall be entitled to practise or have a right of audience in the High Court;”.

Passed in Parliament this *10th* day of *November*, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eighty-one.
