**THE CUSTOMS ACT**

**(Cap. 271)**

**THE CUSTOMS (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1992**

**Short title.**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 248 of the Customs Act, the President acting in accordance with the advice of the Cabinet, hereby makes the following regulations—

**Commencement.**

1. These regulations shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of October, 1990.

**Amendment of regulation 110 (2), Volume VIII page 2057.**

2. Sub-regulation (2) of regulation 110 of the Customs Regulations is amended by deleting the words “four pence per package or six shillings and eight pence per ton, whichever is the less” appearing in lines three and four thereof and substituting therefor the words “two and half percent of the c.i.f. value of the goods”.
