THE ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, 1964
(No. 62 of 1964)

THE FUEL VEHICLES (PARKING) REGULATIONS, 1980

Short title.

In exercise of the power conferred on him by section 56 of the Road Traffic Act, 1964 the President acting on the advice of the Cabinet hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. No person shall park on any highway throughout Sierra Leone a fuel vehicle between dusk and dawn.

Parking of fuel vehicles.

2. Any person who contravenes Regulation 1 shall be guilty of an offence and shall on summary conviction be liable to a fine of one hundred leones, or in case of second or subsequent offence to a fine of hundred leones or imprisonment to six months or to both such fine and imprisonment.

Penalty.

3. In Regulation 1 the term "Fuel Vehicle" means a vehicle specially built for transporting of highly inflammable or gaseous substance and includes a vehicle carrying petrol, kerosene or other inflammable or gaseous substance in large quantities.

Meaning of Fuel vehicles.
