(P.N. No. 25 of 1992)Short title. **THE PUBLIC EMERGENCY (RESTRICTION AND DETENTION) (No. 21) ORDER, 1993**

WHEREAS the National Provisional Ruling Council is satisfied that it is expedient to prevent Paramount Chief Alimamy Dura No 71, Sackville Street, Freetown, in the Western Area of Sierra Leone from acting in any manner prejudicial to public safety and that by reason thereof it is necessary to exercise control over him:

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by regulation 7 of the Public Emergency Regulations, 1992 the National Provisional Ruling Council makes the following order:

- Commence-
ment. 1. This order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 29th day of April, 1993.
- Certain per-
son to be de-
tained under
house deten-
tion. 2. The above named Chief Alimamy Dura shall be detained at and confined to his residence No. 71, Sackville Street, Freetown only.
- Restriction
of move-
ment, asso-
ciation and
communica-
tion. 3. He shall not depart nor travel from Sierra Leone and shall not associate nor communicate with others, nor shall he disseminate or propagate any opinion within or outside Sierra Leone.
- Political acti-
vities prohi-
bited. 4. He shall not participate in nor engage himself in any political activity whatsoever.
