**THE MINERALS ACT**  
(Cap. 196)

THE GENERAL MINERALS (AMENDMENT) RULES, 1982 Short title.

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 92(c) of the Minerals Act, the President acting in accordance with the advice of the Cabinet hereby makes the following Rules:—

1. These Rules shall be deemed to have come into force on the 2nd day of December, 1977. Commencement.

2. Rule 32 of the General Minerals Rules is hereby revoked and replaced by the following new Rule— Replacement of Rule 32 of Vol. VIII Page 1703.

“32. The lessee of a mining lease shall pay the rents following—

(a) in the case of a lease of classes A, C, E, F, or G six leones an acre or part thereof;

(b) in the case of lease of Class B or D three leones an acre or part thereof:

Provided that the President may, for good and sufficient cause, reduce either temporarily or for the remainder of the term of a lease the rent payable.”
