An Act to Amend the Commissions of Inquiry Act Cap. 54.

[1st January, 1963.] Date of commencement.

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the House of Representatives in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Commissions of Inquiry (Amendment) Act, 1964, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of January, 1963. Short title and commencement.

of section 15
of Cap 54.

2. Section 15 of the Commissions of Inquiry Act is hereby amended—

- (a) by the substitution for the words “voted by the House of Representatives” in the third line thereof of the words “approved by the Minister of Finance”;
- (b) by the substitution for the comma in the fourth line thereof of a full stop;
- (c) by the substitution for the words “but the Governor” in the fourth line thereof of the words “The Minister of Finance”;
- (d) by the substitution for the word “Governor” in the eleventh line thereof of the words “Minister of Finance.”.

Passed in the House of Representatives this 16th day of April, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-four.
