

## PUBLIC NOTICE No. 11 OF 1987

*Published 21st May, 1987***THE CUSTOMS ACT****(Cap. 271)**

Short title.

**THE CUSTOMS (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1987**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the President by Section 248 of the Customs Act (Cap. 271) and acting in accordance with the advice of the Cabinet the following Regulations are hereby made:—

Commencement.

1. These Regulations shall be deemed to have come into force on the 10th day of February, 1987.

Abolition of Invoice Entry Fees and Import Licence Fees.

2. (1) The payment of Invoice Entry Fees and the payment of Import Licence Fees are hereby abolished and accordingly the following enactments are hereby revoked—

- (i) subregulations (2) and (3) of regulation 17 of the Customs Regulations (p 2057 of Laws of Sierra Leone Vol. VIII);
  - (ii) the Customs (Amendment) (No. 3) Regulations, 1976 (P.N. No. 30 of 1976);
  - (iii) the Customs (Amendment) Regulations, 1977 (P.N. No. 3 of 1977);
  - (iv) the Customs (Amendment) Regulations, 1978 (P.N. No. 38 of 1978);
  - (v) the Customs (Amendment) Regulations, 1980 (P.N. No. 12 of 1980);
  - (vi) the Customs (Amendment) Regulations, 1981 (P.N. No. 6 of 1981);
  - (vii) the Customs (Amendment) (No. 2), Regulations, 1982 (P.N. No. 20 of 1982); and
  - (viii) the Customs (Amendment) Regulations, 1985 (P.N. No. 21 of 1985)
- (2) Subregulation (4) of regulation 17 of the Customs Regulations (p 2057 of The Laws of Sierra Leone Vol VIII) is hereby re-numbered as subregulation (2).
