The Bank of Sierra Leone (Amendment) Act, 1966

Short title.

Being An Act to Extend the Limits within which Coins may be offered
as Legal Tender in view of the issue of a Limited Number
of Gold Coins to Mark the Fifth Anniversary
of Independence

[26th April, 1966.] Date of
commence-
ment.

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and
with the advice and consent of the House of Representatives in
this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:—

1. This Act shall come into operation on the 26th day of
April, 1966. Commence-
ment.

Amendment
of section 23
of Act No. 6
of 1963.

2. Subsection (2) of section 23 of the Bank of Sierra Leone Act, 1963 is hereby repealed and replaced by the following new subsection—

“(2) Coins issued by the Bank shall, if such coins have not been tampered with, be legal tender in Sierra Leone at their face value for any amount in the case of denominations of not less than twelve and a half Leones and up to an amount not exceeding twenty Leones in the case of denominations of not less than five cents and up to an amount not exceeding one Leone in the case of coins of a lower denomination.”

Passed in the House of Representatives this *31st* day of *March*, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-six.
