**The Larceny (Special Provisions) (Amendment)
Act, 1984**

Short title.

Being an Act to amend the Larceny (Special Provisions) Act, 1976
(Act No. 6 of 1976)

[20th September, 1984] Date of commencement.

BE IT ENACTED by the President and Members of Parliament in this present Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1. The Larceny (Special Provisions) Act, 1976 (Act No. 6 of 1976) is hereby amended by the substitution for section 2 thereof of the following new section—

“Application of Larceny Act, 1916. 2. The provisions of sections 1 and 35 of the Larceny Act, 1916 shall apply for the purposes of this Act as they apply for the purposes of that Act in its application in Sierra Leone.”

Section 2 of Act No. 6 of 1976 replaced.

Section 3 of
principal Act
replaced.

2. The principal Act is hereby further amended by the substitution for section 3 thereof of the following new section—

"Larceny
from aircraft,
ships, etc.

3. Any person who steals any goods—

- (a) from any aircraft on any airfield, or
- (b) within or from any building, structure, container, receptacle or vehicle within the area of any airfield, or
- (c) from any ship at any port, or
- (d) within, or from any building, structure, container, receptacle or vehicle within the area of any port,

shall be guilty of an offence and shall, on conviction on indictment, be liable to imprisonment for a term not being less than ten years but not exceeding twenty-five years."

Passed in Parliament this *11th* day of *September* in the year of our Lord ~~one~~ thousand nine hundred and eighty-four.
