**THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT, 2004**  
(Act No. 1 of 2004)

THE KENEMA CITY COUNCIL (ESTABLISHMENT) ORDER, 2006 Short title.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by subsection (2) of section 2 of the Local Government Act, 2004, the President, acting on the recommendation of the Minister of Local Government and Community Development, the Minister of Finance and the National Electoral Commission, hereby makes the following Order:—

1. (1) The area specified in the Schedule is hereby declared Declaration of locality.

- (2) The locality shall be called the Kenema City.
  
2. The Kenema City shall have a council which shall consist Establishment of Council.

  - (a) the Chairperson, who shall be called “Mayor”;
  - (b) eleven other members elected from wards in the Kenema City; and
  - (c) the Paramount Chief of Nongowa Chiefdom.
  
3. The principal offices of the Kenema City Council shall be Principal offices of Kenema City Council.
