(SUSPENSION OF BANKING BUSINESS) (No. 2) ORDER, 1994

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Bank of Sierra Leone by subsection (3) of section 19 of the Banking Act, 1970, the Governor of the Bank of Sierra Leone makes the following order —

1. This order shall come into force on the 3rd day of August, 1994. Commencement.

2. ALL BANKING TRANSACTIONS at the INTERNATIONAL BANK FOR TRADE AND INDUSTRY (S.L.) LIMITED, except for the transfer to Sierra Leone of funds held with Banks abroad, are suspended for a period of six months from the commencement of this order unless sooner revoked by the BANK OF SIERRA LEONE. Suspension of banking transactions with I.B.T.I.
