Short title.

THE TRADE MARKS (AMENDMENT) RULES, 2000

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by paragraph (c) of subsection (1) of section 55 of the Trade Marks Act, the Minister of Finance acting in accordance with the advice of the Cabinet hereby makes the following Rules:—

1. These Rules shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of January, 2000.

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2. The Trade Marks Rules are amended by the revocation and replacement of Part II thereof by the following Part:—

"PART II—FEES

1. On application for registration of a trade mark for one or more articles included in one class 200,000.00
2. For registering a series of trade marks, for every additional representation after the first in each class 100,000.00
3. On notice of opposition, for each application opposed by opponent 100,000.00
4. On application to register a subsequent proprietor in cases of assignment or merger of the first mark 100,000.00
5. For every additional mark assigned or merged at the same time 50,000.00
6. On application to register a subsequent proprietor in the case of a registered user	100,000.00

7.	For continuance of mark at the expiration of 14 years	200,000.00
8.	For altering address on the register, for every mark	50,000.00
9.	For every entry in the register of a rectification such as amendment of goods or class	50,000.00
10.	For every entry in the register of a rectification thereof or any alteration therein not otherwise charged	50,000.00
11.	For cancelling the entry, or part of a trade mark upon the register, on the application of the owner of such trade mark	50,000.00
12.	On request to registrar to correct a clerical error or permit amendment of application under section 34	50,000.00
13.	For certificate of refusal at the same time for more than one trade mark and for each additional trade mark after the first	50,000.00
14.	For certificate of registration to be used in legal proceedings	50,000.00
15.	For certificate of registrar under rule 25, other than certificate of registration to be used in legal proceedings	50,000.00
16.	For inspecting register, for every half-hour	2,000.00
17.	For inspecting documents lodged in connection with the registration of trade mark	10,000.00
18.	For copies or extracts, for every 72 words or part thereof	5,000.00
19.	For certifying copies or extracts			10,000.00"
