The Control of Betting and Lotteries (Amendment) Act, 1981 Short title.

[1st January, 1981] Date of commencement.

BE IT ENACTED by the President and Members of Parliament in this present Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1. This Act shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of January, 1981. Commencement.

Repeal and replacement of Section 7 (1) of Act No. 3 of 1969.

2. Subsection (1) of section 7 of the Control of Betting and Lotteries Act, 1969 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act) is hereby repealed and replaced by the following new subsection—

“(1) Every winner or other person to whom any prize-money in respect of any winnings in a football pool is paid or payable shall pay on that prize-money, a tax at the rate of thirty *per centum* or at such other rate or rates as the Minister may from time to time specify by Order published in the *Gazette*.”

Repeal and replacement of Section 8 (1) of Act No. 3 of 1969.

3. Subsection (1) of section 8 of the principal Act is hereby repealed and replaced by the following new subsection—

“(1) There is hereby imposed a tax at the rate of thirty *per centum*, or at such other rate or rates as the Minister may from time to time specify by Order published in the *Gazette*, upon all sums paid as stakes by competitors by way of betting on football pools.”

Passed in Parliament this 14th day of April, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eighty-one.
