The Constitution (Amendment) Act, 1973

Short title.

[5th July, 1973.] Commence-
ment.

BE IT ENACTED by the President and Members of Parliament in this present Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1. Paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of section 21 of the Constitution is hereby replaced by the following new paragraph—
 “(b) a Citizen of Sierra Leone (otherwise than by naturalization) whose father and father’s father are or were persons of negro African descent; and”.
