The Customs (Amendment) Act, 1979

[20th September, 1979]

Short title.
Date of

BE IT ENACTED by the President and Members of Parliament in this present Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1. Section 183 of the Customs Act is hereby amended by renumbering the existing section to read "183 (1)" and inserting immediately thereafter the following new subsection—

“(2) Every person who is in any way concerned in any fraudulent evasion or attempt at evasion of any export duties of diamonds shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a penalty of six times the value of the diamonds or five thousand leones whichever shall be greater and all the diamonds in respect of which such an offence is committed shall be forfeited to the State.”

Passed in Parliament this 31st day of *August* in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-nine.
