**THE ARMS AND AMMUNITION (AMENDMENT) RULES, 1993**

Short title.

In exercise of the powers conferred on it by subsection (2) of section 41 of the Arms and Ammunition Act, 1955 as adapted by paragraph 5 of the Administration of Sierra Leone (National Provisional Ruling Council) Proclamation, 1992, the National Provisional Ruling Council makes the following rules—

Commencement.

1. These rules shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of July, 1992.

Amendment of First Schedule to P.N. No. 143 of 1960.

2. The First Schedule to the Arms and Ammunition Rules 1960 is amended by—

(a) the substitution for item 4 of the following new item—

“4 (i) Permit to possess Fire-arms Le19,000

(ii) Small arms licences (pistols and revolvers) Le20,000”

(b) the substitution for item 5 of the following new item—

“5 Licence to keep private fire-arms warehouse Le50,000”

(c) the insertion immediately after item 8 of the following new item—

“9 Corrosive licence Le5,000 to Le10,000”
