Being an Act to provide for the Service of Sierra Leone for the year
1987/88[1st July, 1987] Date of
commen-
ment.WHEREAS it is necessary to make provision for the Service of
Sierra Leone for the year 1987/88:BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the President and Members of
Parliament in this present Parliament assembled as follows:—1. This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on
the 1st day of July, 1987. Commem-
ment.

2. The sum of One Billion, Seventy Eight Million, Thirty Six Thousand and Fifty-one Leones shall be and is hereby granted to His Excellency the President for and during the year Nineteen Hundred and Eighty-seven/Eighty-eight and the same shall be applied and expended in the manner herein described and for the several services set forth in the Schedule.

3. The said sum of One Billion, Seventy Eight Million, Thirty Six Thousand and Fifty-one Leones shall be and is hereby declared to be charged upon and made payable from and out of the Consolidated Fund for the year Nineteen Hundred and Eighty-seven/Eighty-eight and the payment thereof shall be taken to begin and commence on and immediately after the first day of July, Nineteen Hundred and Eighty-seven.

4. The Accountant-General is hereby authorised and required to pay out of the Consolidated Fund for the several services specified in the Schedule such sums as may be specified in the Warrant or Order of the Minister of Finance issued from time to time up to the total sum of One Billion, Seventy Eight Million, Thirty Six Thousand and Fifty-one Leones which shall come in course of payment during the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, Nineteen Hundred and Eighty-eight.

Excess of
Expenditure.

5. The amount from time to time paid for and in respect of expenditure authorised in section 2 shall not exceed in the aggregate the sum of One Billion, Seventy Eight Million, Thirty Six Thousand and Fifty-one Leones from the first day of July, Nineteen Hundred and Eighty-seven inclusive, and any balances remaining unissued at the end of June, Nineteen Hundred and Eighty-eight shall lapse and not be available for making payments in the following year.
