THE STATE SALARIES, PENSIONS, GRATUITIES AND OTHER BENEFITS ACT, 2003 (Act No. 4 of 2003)

THE STATE SALARIES (PENSION OF SPEAKER AND MEMBERS OF PARLIAMENT) ORDER, 2006 Short title.

In exercise of the powers conferred on Parliament by subsection (2) of section 5 of the State Salaries, Pensions, Gratuities and Other Benefits Act, 2003, the Speaker of Parliament hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 2nd day of April, 1996. Commence-
ment.

2. The Speaker or a Member of Parliament who has served as such for a period of- Computation

 - (a) not less than five years but less than ten years, shall be entitled to a monthly pension computed at the rate of forty percent of the gross salary of a Speaker or Member of Parliament;

- (b) ten years or more shall be entitled to a monthly pension computed at the rate of eighty percent of the gross salary of a Speaker or Member of Parliament.

Application. 3. This Order shall apply to a Speaker or Member of Parliament elected as such on or after coming into operation of this Order.
