An Act to Amend the Provinces Act

Cap. 60.

[9th December, 1933.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the House of Representatives in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Provinces (Amendment) Act, 1964, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the ninth day of December, 1933.

2. Section 3 of the Provinces Act is hereby repealed and replaced by the following new section—

“ Duties and
powers of
Assistant
District
Officer.

3. Subject to any special instructions from the Provincial Secretary, any Assistant District Officer of any District may perform any of the duties and functions and exercise any of the powers (including judicial powers) of the District Officer of that District but shall perform and exercise only such portion thereof as may from time to time be assigned to him by the District Officer.”.
