THE CONTROL OF GOODS (PRICE TICKETS) ORDER, 1983 Short title.

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by rule 3 of the Volume VIII
Control of Goods Rules, the Controller hereby makes the following Page 1914.

1. This Order shall be deemed to have come into operation on Commence-
the 20th day of January, 1983. ment.

2. (1) Any person who deals in any kind of goods specified in Price tickets.
the Schedule to this Order shall cause to be attached to any such
goods, displayed for sale by retail, a price ticket, showing the retail
price of such goods in English.

(2) Any such price ticket shall be clearly legible and shall
be visible to the public.

(3) Where any kind of goods specified in the said Schedule
is displayed in different qualities or sizes, the price of each quality
or size shall be indicated by means of a price ticket.
