**The Tribal Administration (Western Area) (Amendment) Short title.  
(No. 2) Act, 1975**

[13th November, 1975.] Date of Commencement.

BE IT ENACTED by the President and Members of Parliament in this present Parliament assembled as follows:—

1. Paragraph (e) of subsection (1) of section 5 of the Tribal Administration (Western Area) Act, is hereby repealed and replaced by the following new paragraph—

Repeal and replacement of section 5 (1) (e) of Cap. 78.

“(e) registration of births, deaths, customary marriages and divorce amongst members of the tribe;”

Amendment  
section 12 follows—  
Cap. 78.

2. Section 12 of the Principal Act is hereby amended as

- (a) by the substitution of a colon for the fullstop at the end thereof, and
- (b) by the addition immediately thereafter of the following proviso—

“ Provided that the Tribal Headman shall not be so liable in the exercise of any of his functions or duties under section 10 of this Act. ”

Passed in Parliament this 30th day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-five.

**The Chiefdom Councils (Amendment) Act, 1975**

Short title.

[13th November, 1975.] Date of commencement.

BE IT ENACTED by the President and Members of Parliament in this present Parliament assembled, as follows:

1. Subsection (1) of Section 4A of the Chiefdom Councils Act is hereby amended as follows—

Amendment of Section 4A (1) of Cap. 61.

- (a) by the substitution of a semi-colon for the full stop at the end of paragraph (e) thereof; and
- (b) by the addition immediately after the said paragraph (e) of the following new paragraph—
- “(f) every member of Parliament representing a Constituency of which the Chieftdom forms a part.”

Passed in Parliament this 9th day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-five.
