**The Constitution (Amendment) (No. 2) Act, 1973**

Short title.  
Date of  
Commence-  
ment.

[17th May, 1973.]

BE IT ENACTED by the President and Members of Parliament in this present Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1. This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 17th day of May, 1973. Commence-  
ment.

2. Section 23 of the Constitution is hereby amended as follows— Amendment  
of Section 23  
of Act No. 6  
of 1971.

(a) by the substitution of a colon for the fullstop at the end of subsection (1) thereof and the addition immediately thereafter of the following proviso—

“ Provided that a person shall be eligible for election as Speaker of Parliament notwithstanding that such person is a Public Officer so however that such person if elected shall retire from the Public Service with full benefits on the day of his election.”;

(b) by the repeal and replacement of paragraph (a) of subsection (3) thereof by the following new paragraph—

“ (a) if he is a member of the armed forces or the holder of any other office of emolument under the Government; or ”.

Passed in Parliament this 25th day of July, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-three.
