The Monuments and Relics (Amendment) Act, 1967 Short title.

Being an Act to Amend the Monuments and Relics Act

Cap. 59.

[16th March, 1967.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the House of Representatives in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. Section 2 of the principal Act is hereby amended by substituting for the definition "Minister" as therein defined the following new definition—

“Minister” means the Minister for the time being charged with responsibility for matters relating to Education;”.

Amendment
of section 7
of Cap. 59.

2. Subsection (1) of section 7 of the principal Act, is hereby amended by the addition at the end thereof of the following new paragraph—

“(1) acquire, maintain and administer the Sierra Leone Museum founded by the Sierra Leone Society and all things movable or immovable thereunto pertaining including the land and building situate at the Lucien Genet Gardens, Pademba Road Freetown.”
