THE FRANCHISE AND ELECTORAL REGISTRATION ACT 1961 (Act No. 44 of 1961)

THE FREETOWN MUNICIPALITY (CONSTITUTION OF WARDS) ORDER, 1974 Short title.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 3 of the Franchise and Electoral Registration Act, 1961 and the Proviso to subsection (2) of section 2 of the Electoral Registration and Freetown Municipality (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1964, the Minister of the Interior hereby makes the following Order:—

1. With effect from the 11th day of May, 1973 the Freetown Municipality shall be divided into eight wards which shall be conterminous with the eight constituencies delimited for the Municipality by the Electoral Commission and approved by Parliament by Resolutions on the 20th day of December, 1972 and the 5th day of March, 1973. Freetown Constituencies to be wards G.N. 368 of 1973.

2. The said wards shall be known as—

Wards.

- Freetown East I
Freetown East II
Freetown East III
Freetown Central I
Freetown Central II
Freetown West I
Freetown West II
Freetown West III

3. The Registers of Electors prepared and actually used in the City of Freetown for the purposes of the General Election of members of Parliament held on the 11th day of May, 1973 may be used for the purpose of the Election of elected Councillors of the City Council of Freetown. Constituency Registers may be used in Municipal Elections.

This order divides the City of Freetown into eight wards for the purposes of the City Council Election. It also permits the use of the Register of Elections prepared for the House of Representatives General Election in 1973.
