The Tourist and Hotel Development (Amendment) Act, 1973 Short title.

[20th September, 1973.] Date of commencement.

BE IT ENACTED by the President and Members of Parliament in this present Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1. Section 2 of the Tourist and Hotel Development Act, 1964, is hereby amended by the repeal of the definition of 'Minister' and the replacement thereof by the following new definition— Amendment to Section 2 of Act No. 61 of 1964.

'Minister' means the Minister for the time being charged with responsibility for matters relating to Tourism and Cultural Affairs.

Passed in Parliament this 29th day of *August*, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-three.
