WHEREAS it is provided by Section 77 of the Constitution and by Section 6 of the Electoral Provisions Act, 1962 (Act No. 14 of 1962) that a General Election of Members of Parliament shall be held at such time not later than the ninetieth day after the dissolution of Parliament or such earlier day as the President may, by Proclamation, appoint;

AND WHEREAS I am advised that it is expedient that a General Election be held for the election of Elected Paramount Chief Members of Parliament and other Elected Members of Parliament on the twenty-ninth day of May, 1986 and the thirtieth day of May, 1986, respectively;

NOW THEREFORE, I JOSEPH SAIDU MOMOH, President of the Republic of Sierra Leone, Supreme Head of State, Grand Commander of the Order of the Republic, Commander-in-Chief of the Armed Forces, Fountain Head of Unity, Honour, Freedom and Justice, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM that a General Election of Members of Parliament aforesaid shall be held on the following dates:

Paramount Chief Members	..	29th day of May, 1986
Other Elected Members	..	30th day of May, 1986

Given under my Hand and the Public Seal of Sierra Leone at the State House, Freetown, in the Western Area of the Republic of Sierra Leone this 7th day of April in the year of Our Lord One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-six.
