**The Forest Industries Corporation (Amendment)
Act, 1973**

Short title.

[5th July, 1973.] Date of
Commence-
ment.

BE IT ENACTED by the President and Members of Parliament in this present Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1. Section 15 of the Forest Industries Corporation Act, 1964 is hereby repealed and replaced by the following new section—

15. (1) There shall be a Secretary of the Corpora-
tion who shall be appointed by the Corporation with
the approval of the Minister, whose function shall,
subject to any directions issued by the Corporation, be
wholly and solely—

- (a) for the recording of all proceedings of meetings of the Corporation; and
- (b) for such other duties as are normally undertaken by such Secretary, which duties shall be completely divorced from the financial affairs of the Corporation.

Appointment of Chief Accountant, his functions and responsibility.

15A. (1) There shall be a Chief Accountant who shall be responsible for the finances of the Corporation and who shall be appointed by the Corporation with the approval of the Minister.

(2) The Chief Accountant shall, subject to any directions issued by the Corporation, control the finance of, and be directly responsible to, the Corporation—

- (a) for the preparation of all accounts and records of the financial transactions of the Corporation;
- (b) for the conduct of all matters connected with the finances of the Corporation in accordance with the provisions of this Act;
- (c) for the performance of such other duties relating to finance, as the Corporation may from time to time direct.”.
