**The Civilian Rule Committee (Establishment)
Decree, 1968**

Short title.

[15th January, 1968.] Date of commencement.

PURSUANT to the Proclamation entitled "Administration of Sierra Leone (National Reformation Council) Proclamation, 1967", published in the *Gazette* on the 25th of March, 1967, the National Reformation Council hereby makes and issues the following Decree:—

1. This Decree shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 15th day of January, 1968. Commencement.

N.R.C. may
appoint
Committee.

2. (1) The National Reformation Council shall have power to appoint a Committee (hereinafter referred to as the Civilian Rule Committee) consisting of such members (not being less than ten) as it may from time to time appoint and to charge such Committee with such functions as it may from time to time specify in writing to the Civilian Rule Committee.

(2) Members of the Civilian Rule Committee shall not be paid any salary but shall be entitled to such allowances as the National Reformation Council may approve.

Election of
Chairman,
and Deputy
Chairman.

3. There shall be a Chairman and a Deputy Chairman of the Civilian Rule Committee who shall be elected by a majority vote at the first meeting of the Civilian Rule Committee from among its members.

Appoint-
ment of
Secretary.

4. There shall be a Secretary of the Civilian Rule Committee who shall be appointed by the National Reformation Council and shall have voice but not vote at the meetings of the Civilian Rule Committee.

Rules of
Procedure.

5. The Civilian Rule Committee shall prescribe such Rules of Procedure as it may consider necessary to govern the conduct of its meetings.
