**NON-CITIZENS (REGISTRATION, IMMIGRATION AND
EXPULSION) ACT, 1965

NON-CITIZENS (REGISTRATION) (AMENDMENT) RULES, 1985 Short title.

to exercise of the powers conferred on the President by paragraphs (d) and (e) of sub-section (1) of Section 40 of the Non-Citizens (Registration, Immigration and Expulsion) Act, 1965 (Act No. 14 of 1965) and acting in accordance with the advice of the Cabinet, Rules are hereby made—

These Rules shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of July, 1985. Commencement.

The Non-Citizens (Registration) Rules, 1967 (P. N. No. 46 of 1967) as amended by the Non-Citizens (Registration) (Amendment) Rules, 1976 (P. N. No. 29 of 1976) are hereby further amended by substitution for rule 4 thereof of the following new rule— Rule 4 of P.N. No. 46 of 1967 replaced.

“Fees. 4. (1) There shall be payable annually by every non-citizen registered under the provisions of rule 3 the following fee—

- (i) in the case of a person other than those referred to in paragraphs (ii) and (iii) this rule, .. Le20.00
- (ii) in the case of petty-trader, .. Le100.00
- (iii) in the case of a Non-Citizen African in gold or diamond business or both Le500.00

(2) Upon registration such a non-citizen shall be issued with an identity card which shall remain valid for a period of one year as from the date of issue, unless defaced, mutilated, destroyed, lost, or the Minister by Notice in the *Gazette* cancels it:

Provided that the President may waive the payment of a fee payable under this rule by any class of persons if he considers that the circumstances justify his so doing.”
