THE FRANCHISE AND ELECTORAL REGISTRATION (EXTENSION OF TIME FOR DELIVERY OF CLAIMS FOR REGISTRATION) ORDER, 1989 Short title.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sub-section (2) of section 27 of the Franchise and Electoral Registration Act, 1961 the Electoral Commission hereby makes the following notice:—

1. The period of fifteen days as provided in section 13 of the Franchise and Electoral Registration Act, 1961 is hereby extended to thirty days as the period within which claims for registration as electors shall be delivered to the Registration Officer for the ward in which his claim is to be registered. Extension of time for giving notice to be registered as an elector.

2. The period of thirty days referred to in paragraph 1 shall begin to run from the 22nd day of January, 1990 and shall end on the 20th day of February, 1990 inclusive. Period within which notice may be given.
