The Bank of Sierra Leone (Amendment) Act, 1983

Short title.

Being an Act to empower the Bank of Sierra Leone to utilise the total outstanding advances made by it to Government for the purchase of securities of Government

[14th July, 1983] Date of commencement.

BE IT ENACTED by the President and Members of Parliament in this present Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Notwithstanding the proviso to paragraph (g) of subsection (1) of section 29 of the Bank of Sierra Leone (Amendment) Act, 1970 (Act No. 10 of 1970), (as replaced by section 5 of the Bank of Sierra Leone (Amendment) Act, 1978 (Act No. 11 of 1978)) the Bank of Sierra Leone may, under the said paragraph (g) utilise the whole of the total advances made by it to the Govern-

Bank of Sierra Leone empowered to purchase Government Securities with outstanding advances to Government.

“(2) The principal sums represented by any Treasury Bills outstanding at any one time under the provisions of this section shall not exceed the estimated revenue of the Government during the financial year then current.”

2. The Treasury Bills (Amendment) Act, 1976 (No. 19 of 1976) is hereby repealed.
