THE PRESIDENTIAL ELECTIONS DECREE, 1995
(N.P.R.C. Decree No. 17 of 1995)

THE PRESIDENTIAL ELECTIONS (APPOINTMENT OF DAY FOR SECOND
BALLOT) PROCLAMATION, 1996

Short title.

WHEREAS by section 16 of the Decree it is provided that a second presidential election shall be held within fourteen days of the announcement of the result of the previous election if no candidate has polled in his favour not less than fifty-five percent of the valid votes cast;

AND WHEREAS at the presidential elections held on the 26th and 27th February, 1996, from the result declared on 2nd March, 1996, no candidate had polled in his favour not less than fifty-five percent of the valid votes cast and it is therefore necessary and expedient that a second election should be held;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by paragraph (b) of section 3 of the Presidential Elections Decree, 1995, the National Provisional Ruling Council, after consultation with the Commission, hereby makes the following proclamation:—

The 15th March, 1996 is hereby appointed as the day of voting in respect of the second election referred to in subsection (2) of section 16 of the Decree.
