THE BUILDING FEES ACT, 1973  
(No. 23 of 1973)

THE BUILDING FEES ORDER, 1987

Short title.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sub-section (1) of section 2 of the Building Fees Act, 1973 the President, acting in accordance with the advice of the Cabinet, hereby makes the following Order:—

1. The fees payable for any service rendered in relation to a Schedule of building, advertisement hoardings, or any kiosk and removal of fees, and for private use shall be in accordance with the scale set out in the Schedule.
2. The fees specified in the Schedule shall be payable to the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Lands, Housing and the Environment or any such officer deputed by the President. Fees to be paid to Permanent Secretary, etc
3. On payment of the fees, the appropriate certificate shall be issued by the collecting officer to the applicant. Certificate to be issued.
4. The Building Fees (No. 2) Order, 1978 is hereby revoked. P.N. No. of 1978 revoked.
