**The Sierra Leone Produce Marketing (Amendment)
Act, 1966** Short title.

[5th May, 1966.] Date of com-
mencement.

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the House of Representatives in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. Section 20 of the Sierra Leone Produce Marketing Act is hereby amended as follows:— Amendment
of section 22
of Cap. 209.

(a) by substituting a colon for the full stop at the end of subsection (1) thereof; and

(b) by adding the following proviso to that subsection—
“Provided that the Board may, if satisfied that no other funds are available for the purpose, apply any sum of money not exceeding one and a half million leones out of the Price Maintenance Fund, to meet any expenditure which in its opinion is urgently required to develop or promote agricultural industry in Sierra Leone.”.

Passed in the House of Representatives this *16th* day of *March*, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-six.
