**The Spirits (Distillation and Licensing) Act, 1962
(Amendment) Decree, 1968**

Short title.

[25th January, 1968.] Date of
commence-
ment.

PURSUANT to the Proclamation entitled "Administration of Sierra Leone (National Reformation Council) Proclamation, 1967", published in the *Gazette* on the 25th of March, 1967, the National Reformation Council hereby makes and issues the following Decree:—

1. Section 5 of the principal Act is hereby repealed and replaced by the following new section—

“Licensing Board. 5. (1) There shall be a Licensing Board to grant omole licences which shall consist of the following members—

- (a) the Comptroller of Customs;
- (b) the Secretary, Department of Trade, Industry and Agriculture; and
- (c) the General Manager of Wellington Distilleries.

(2) The Board shall elect its own Chairman, and regulate its procedure.

(3) All licences issued by the former Board are hereby revoked.”

Amendment
of Section 7
of Act No. 5
of 1962.

2. Section 7 of the principal Act is hereby amended as follows—

(a) by inserting immediately after subsection (5) thereof the following new subsection—

“ (6) Every omole licence shall also specify the quantity of omole which the holder is thereby entitled to manufacture within a specified time. ”;

(b) by re-numbering the existing subsections “ (6), (7) and (8) ” as “ (7), (8) and (9) ” respectively.
