PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency, Dr. Siaka Stevens, President of the Republic, Supreme Head of State, Grand Commander of the Order of the Republic, Commander-in-Chief of the Armed Forces, Fountain Head of Unity, Honour, Freedom and Justice.

WHEREAS by Sections 74 and 75 of the Constitution it is provided that a Session of Parliament shall be held at such place within Sierra Leone and shall commence at such time as the President may by Proclamation appoint and that the President may at any time prorogue Parliament:

NOW, THEREFORE, I SIAKA STEVENS, President, Supreme Head of State, Grand Commander of the Order of the Republic, Commander-in-Chief of the Armed Forces of Sierra Leone, do by this my Proclamation prorogue Parliament with effect from the 2nd day of June, 1983 and DO HEREBY FURTHER proclaim and appoint that a Session of Parliament shall be held at Parliament Building, Tower Hill, commencing on Friday, the 3rd day of June, 1983 at 10 o'clock in the forenoon.

Given under my hand and the Public Seal of the State of Sierra Leone, at the State House, Freetown, this 27th day of May, in the year of Our Lord, One thousand, nine hundred and eighty-three.
