**THE PUBLIC EMERGENCY (RESTRICTION AND DETENTION) (No. 26) Short title.
ORDER, 1993**

WHEREAS the National Provisional Ruling Council is satisfied that it is expedient to prevent S. B. Marrah of No. 22, Carlton Carew Lane, Thompson Bay, Freetown, in the Western Area of Sierra Leone from acting in any manner prejudicial to public safety and that by reason thereof it is necessary to exercise control over him:

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by regulation 7 of the Public Emergency Regulations, 1992 the National Provisional Ruling Council makes the following order:—

1. This order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 12th day of April, 1993. Commencement.
2. The above named S. B. Marrah shall be detained at and confined to his residence No. 22, Carlton Carew Lane, Thompson Bay only. Certain person to be detained under house detention.
3. He shall not depart nor travel from Sierra Leone and shall not associate nor communicate with others, nor shall he disseminate or propagate any opinion within or outside Sierra Leone. Restriction of movement, association and communication.
4. He shall not participate in nor engage himself in any political activity whatsoever. Political activities prohibited.
