PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency Dr. Siaka Probyn Stevens, President of the Republic, Supreme Head of State, Grand Commander of the Order of the Republic, Commander-in-Chief of the Armed Forces, Fountain Head of Unity, Honour, Freedom and Justice.

WHEREAS by Section 41 of the Constitution it is provided that when the seat of any Member of Parliament becomes vacant, the vacancy shall be filled by election in accordance with the provisions of any law relating to such election:

AND WHEREAS Section 6 of the Electoral Provisions Act, 1962 provides that the President may by Proclamation appoint a time for a bye-election to Parliament:

AND WHEREAS I am advised that vacancies exist in the Constituencies listed in the Schedule hereto and that it is expedient that bye-elections shall be held in each of those Constituencies on the 26th day of June, 1982:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, SIAKA PROBYN STEVENS, President of the Republic, Supreme Head of State, Grand Commander of the Order of the Republic, Commander-in-Chief of the Armed Forces of Sierra Leone, Fountain Head of Unity, Honour, Freedom and Justice DO HEREBY PROCLAIM AND APPOINT the 26th day of June, 1982 as the time for holding the bye-elections in the Constituencies listed in the Schedule hereto, in accordance with the provisions of the Electoral Provisions Act, 1962.
