THE STATE SALARIES, PENSIONS, GRATUITIES AND OTHER
BENEFITS ACT, 2003
(Act No. 4 of 2003)

THE MINISTERS AND DEPUTY MINISTERS (PENSION) ORDER, 2009 Short title.

In exercise of the powers conferred on Parliament by subsection (2) of section 5 of the State Salaries, Pensions, Gratuities and Other Benefits Act, 2003, the Speaker of Parliament hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 18th day of April 1996. Commencement.
2. A Minister or Deputy Minister who has served for a period of-
 - (a) not less than five years but less than ten years shall be entitled to a monthly pension computed at the rate of forty percent of his gross salary as Minister or Deputy Minister;
 - (b) ten years or more shall be entitled to a monthly pension computed at the rate of eighty percent of the gross salary as Minister or Deputy Minister.Computation of pension of Ministers and Deputy Ministers.
3. Paragraph 3 of the Presidents, Vice-Presidents, Ministers and Deputy Ministers (Conditions of Service) Order, 2008 is revoked. Revocation of paragraph 3 of S. I. No. 11 of 2008.
