THE PARLIAMENTARY ELECTIONS (APPOINTMENT OF ELECTION DAY) Short title.
(AMENDMENT) PROCLAMATION, 2002.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 42 of the Electoral Laws Act, 2002, the President, after consultation with the Electoral Commission, hereby makes the following Proclamation:—

1. The Parliamentary Elections (Appointment of Election Day) Proclamation, 2002 is amended by the insertion immediately after paragraph 2 thereof, of the following new paragraph:—

2. The following persons, are authorised to vote on 10th May, 2002:—

- (a) any elector who is unable to vote on election day by reason of being on official duties connected with the election, including the permanent and temporary staff of the Electoral Commission;
- (b) members of the Sierra Leone Police and the Armed Forces of the Republic or Sierra Leone who will be on duty on the election day:

Provided that a person referred to in paragraph (a) or (b) of paragraph 2 shall be certified by the appropriate authority as falling within those paragraphs;

- (c) any other elector in respect of whom the Electoral Commission is satisfied that such elector will be unable, for good cause, to vote on the 14th of May, 2002".
